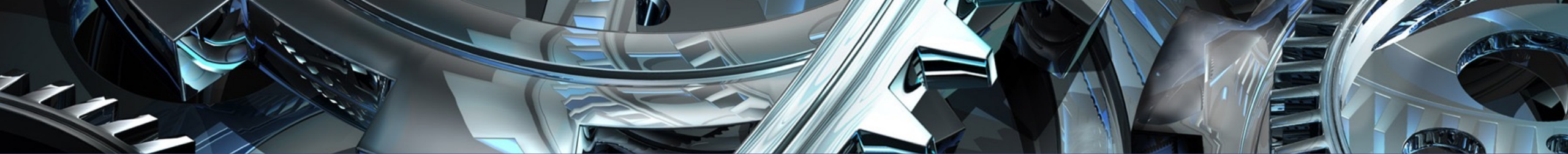

## **The Problem**

**The current Tab bars on native could be changed to give the users a better user experience and navigational path.**

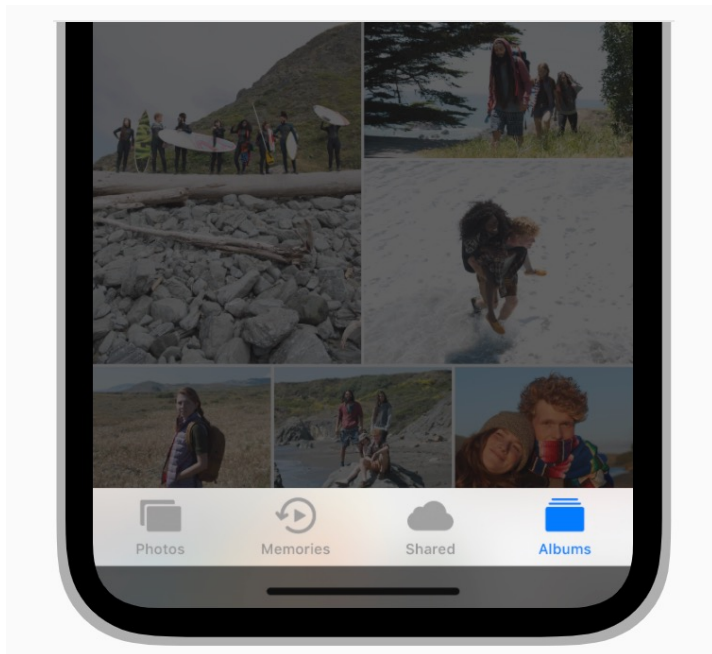
**On Apps the tab bar should be at the top of a hierarchal path and not show sub categorieis**



# Guidelines



## IOS Tab bar guidelines

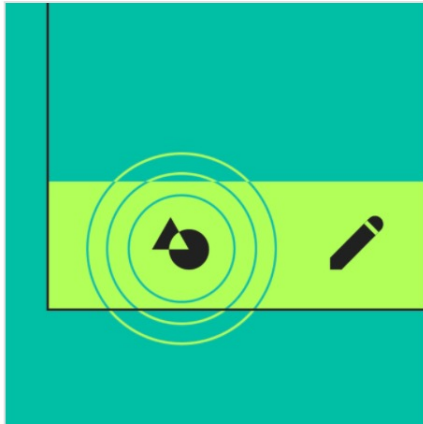


- Use a tab bar to organize information at the app level
- Use a tab bar strictly for navigation.
- Don't remove or disable a tab when its function is unavailable
- Always switch contexts in the attached view
- Make sure tab bar glyphs are visually consistent and balanced

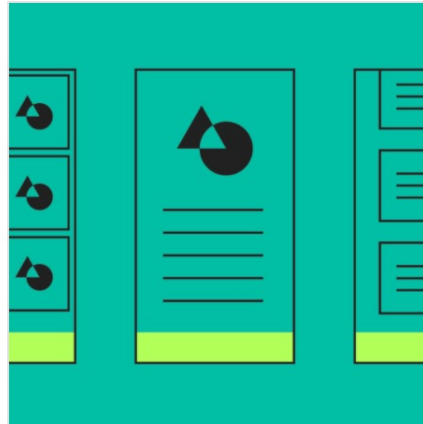

## Tab bar guidelines



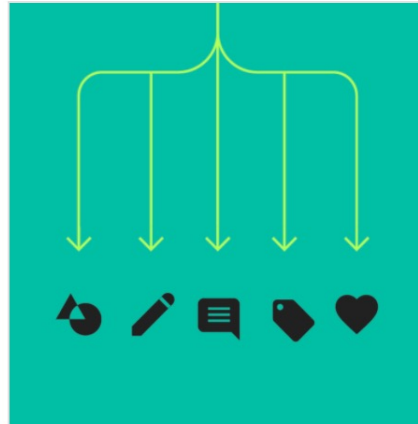
### Ergonomic

The bottom navigation bar is easy to reach on a handheld mobile device.



### Consistent

When used, the bottom navigation bar appears at the bottom of every screen.



### Related

Bottom navigation bar destinations should be of equal importance.

### Should be used for:

- Top-level destinations that need to be accessible from anywhere in the app
- Three to five destinations
- Mobile or tablet only

### Shouldn't be used for:

- Single tasks, such as viewing a single email
- User preferences or settings

## IOS Use of web views guidelines

**Avoid using a web view to build a web browser.** Using a web view to let people briefly access a website without leaving the context of your app is fine, but Safari is the primary way people browse the web on iOS. Attempting to replicate the functionality of Safari in your app is unnecessary and discouraged.

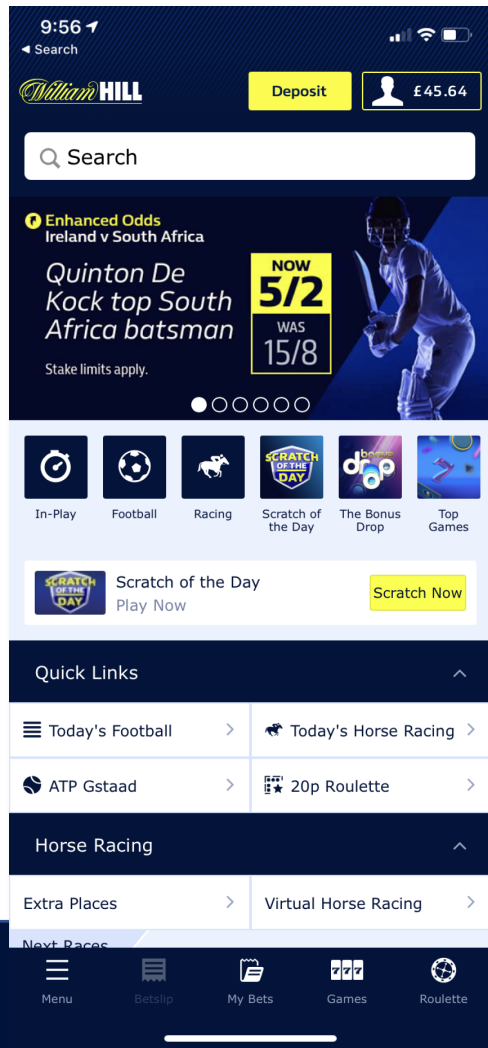
#### Apple rejected the Sportsbook Italy iOS app with the following feedback:

“Your app provides a limited user experience as it is not sufficiently different from a mobile browsing experience. As such, the experience it provides is similar to the general experience of using Safari. Including iOS features such as push notifications, Core Location, and sharing do not provide a robust enough experience to be appropriate for the App Store.”

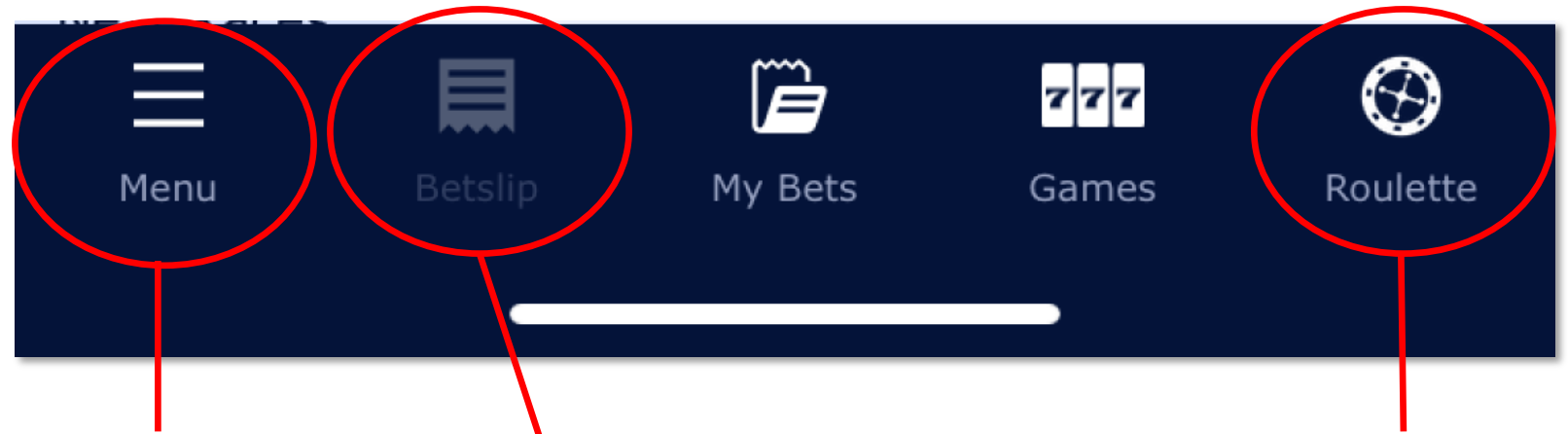

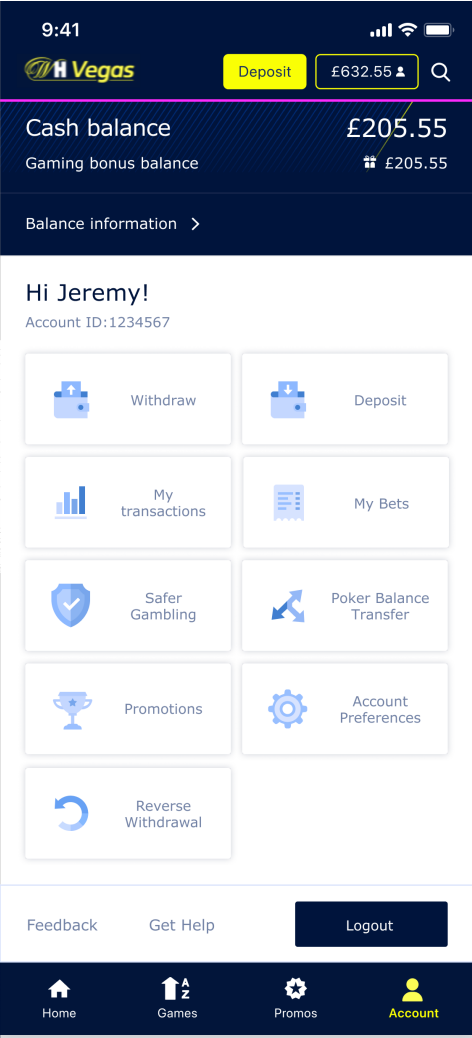
The burger menu is usually used as a more menu but on the right hand side

# What was tested

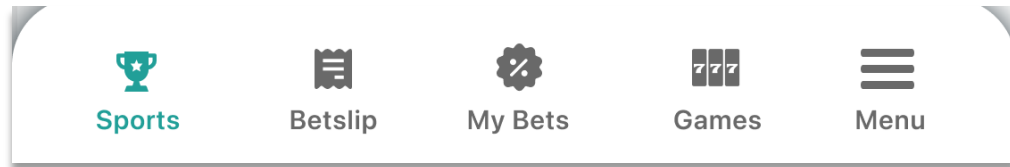
1. Navigate to Todays Football
2. Place a bet on Malmo Ludogorets to draw
3. Now you have placed a bet where would you navigate to see it.
4. Where would you Navigate to find a Roulette game
5. Where would you navigate to find Games
6. Navigate to where you would find Sports
7. Where would you navigate to if you wanted to find out information about your account

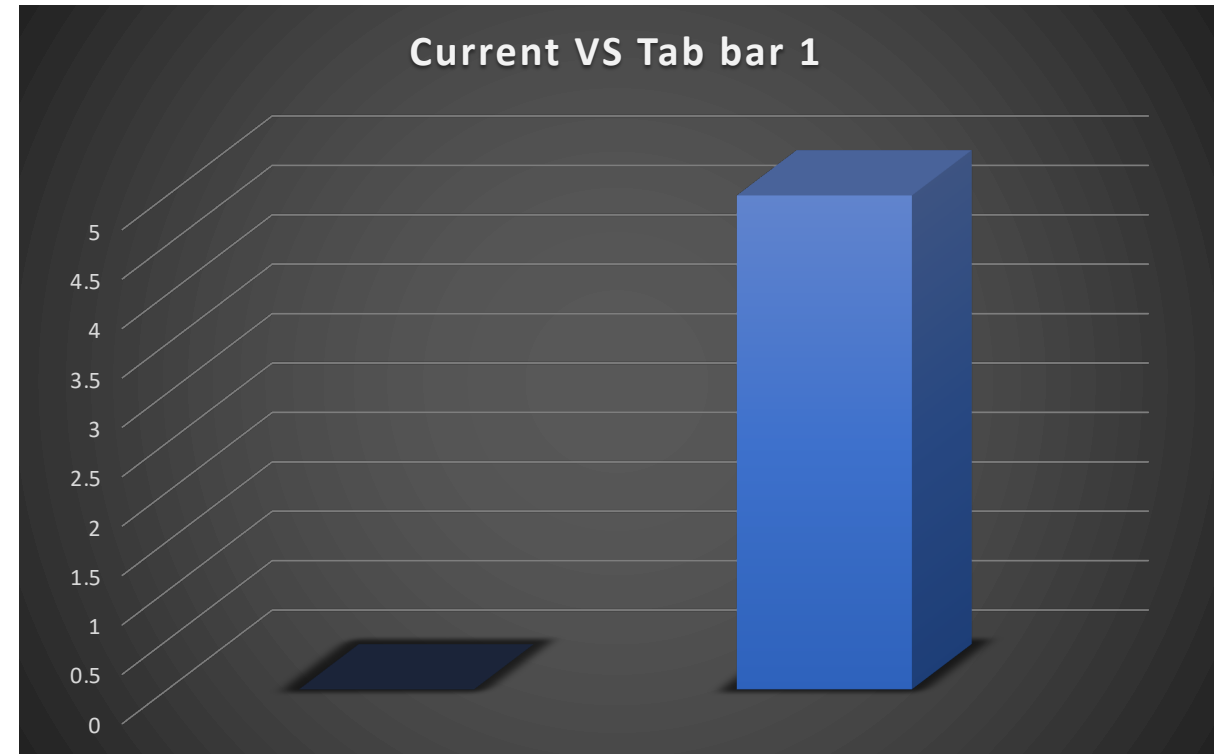

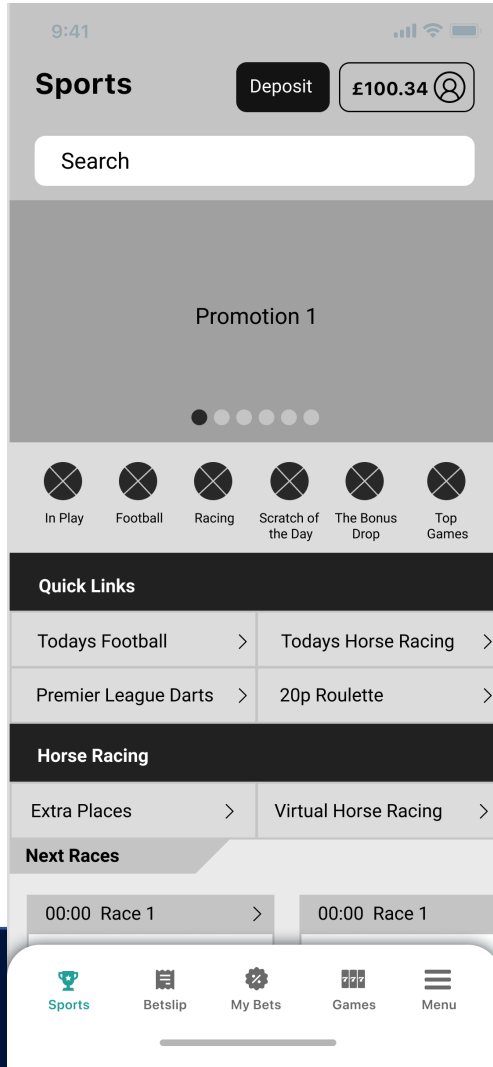
## Observations

- Roulette is not needed on the tab bar if users go to games and see roulette there.

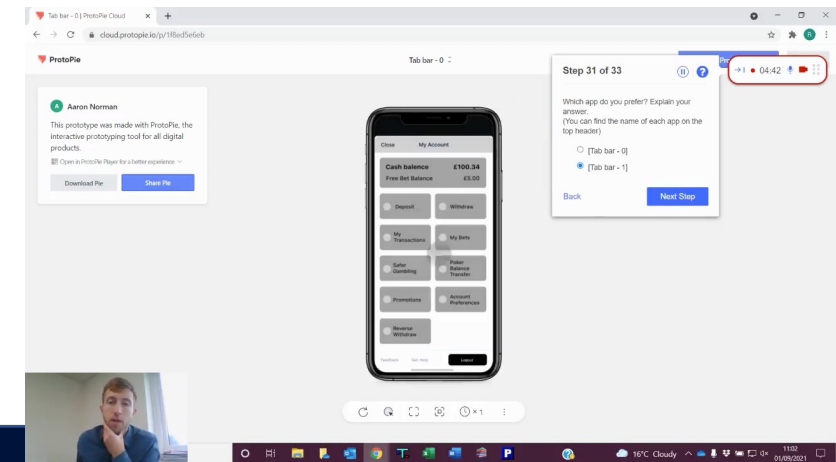
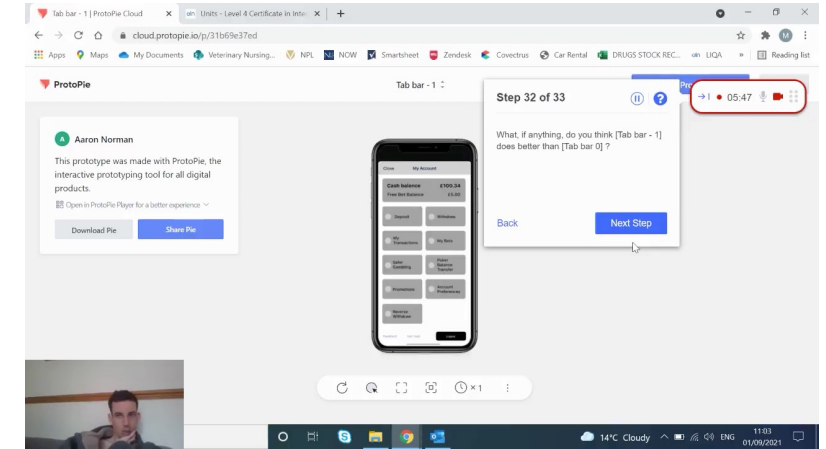
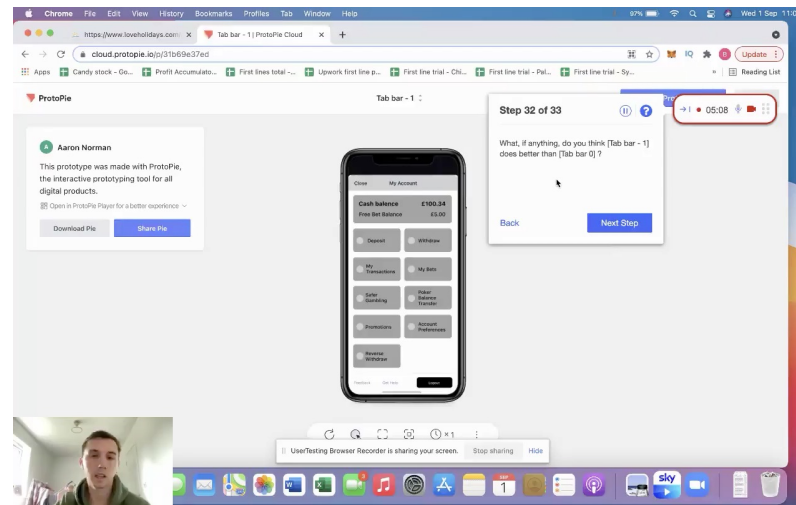

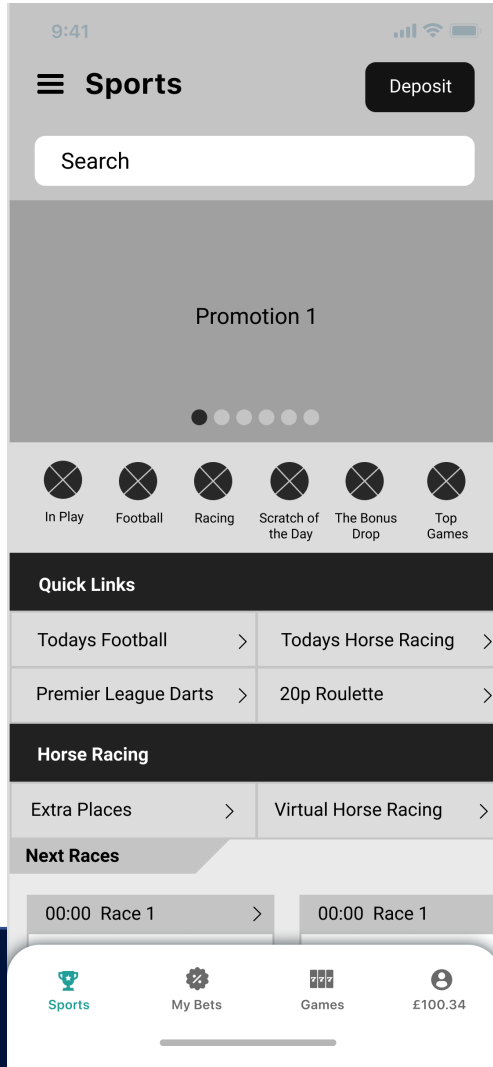
## Observations

- Roulette being put on the tab bar was confusing to users. 2/5 user felt that space could be used for a favourites category rather than roulette as not everyone wants to play Roulette.

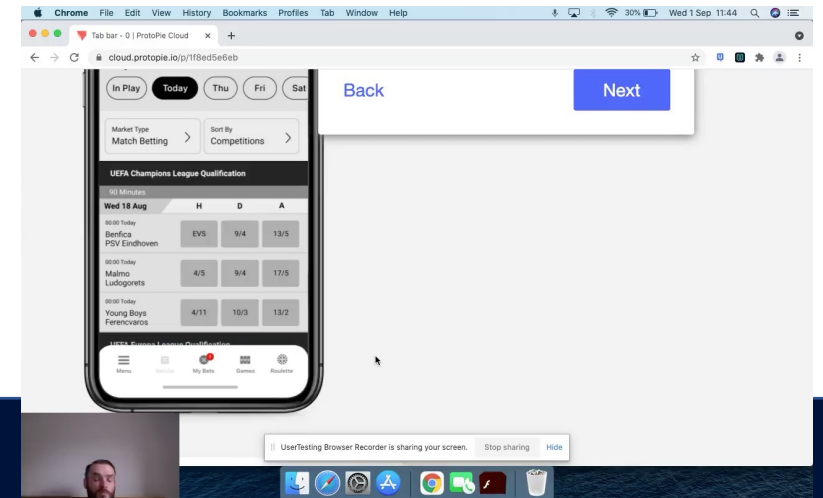
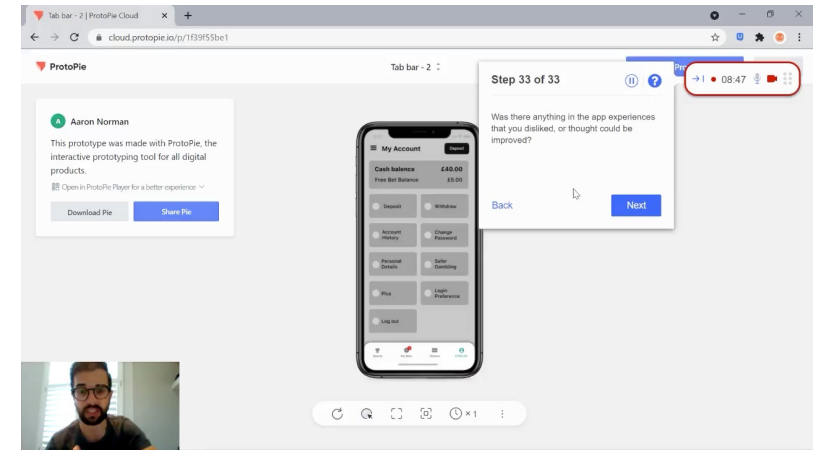
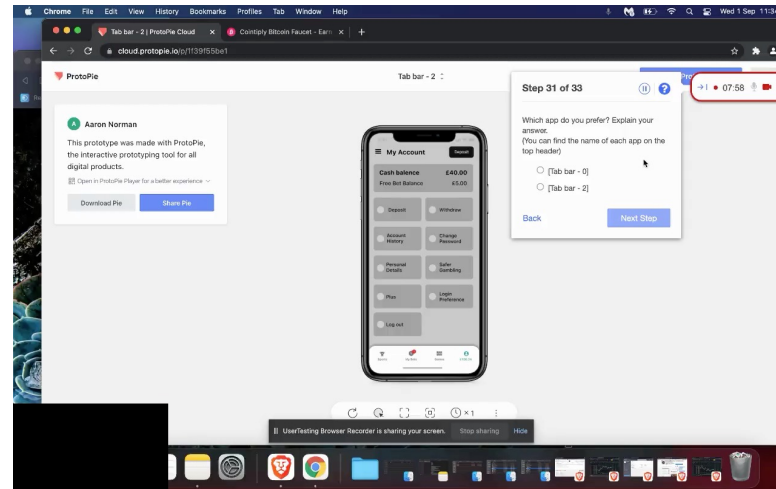

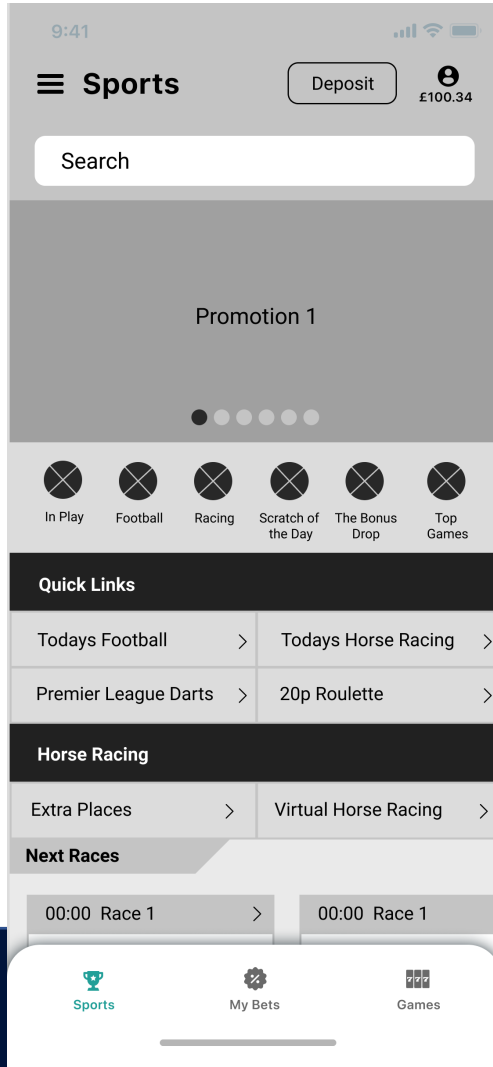
## Observations

- Navigation was better on tab bar 3

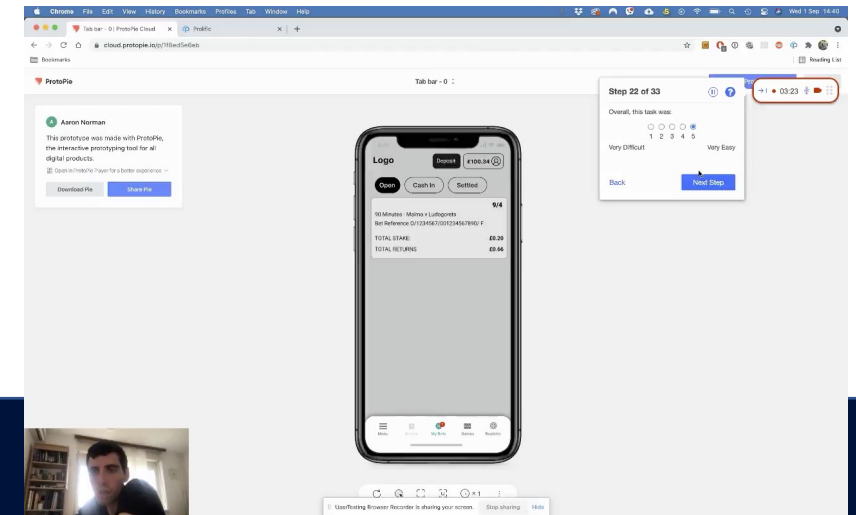
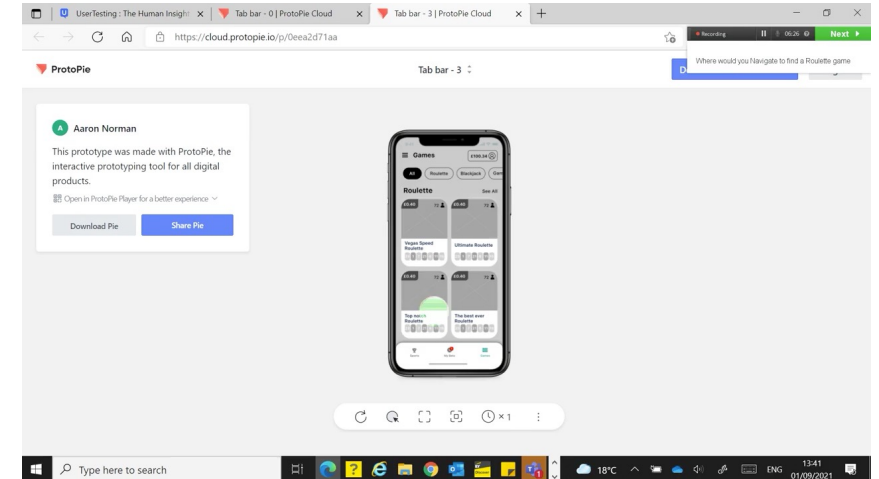
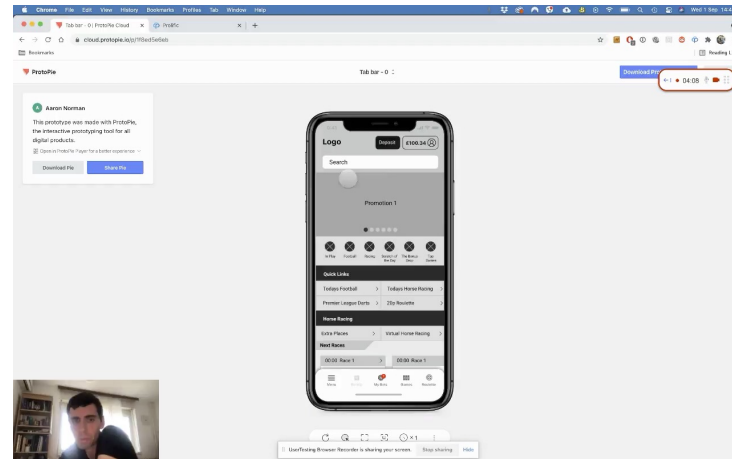

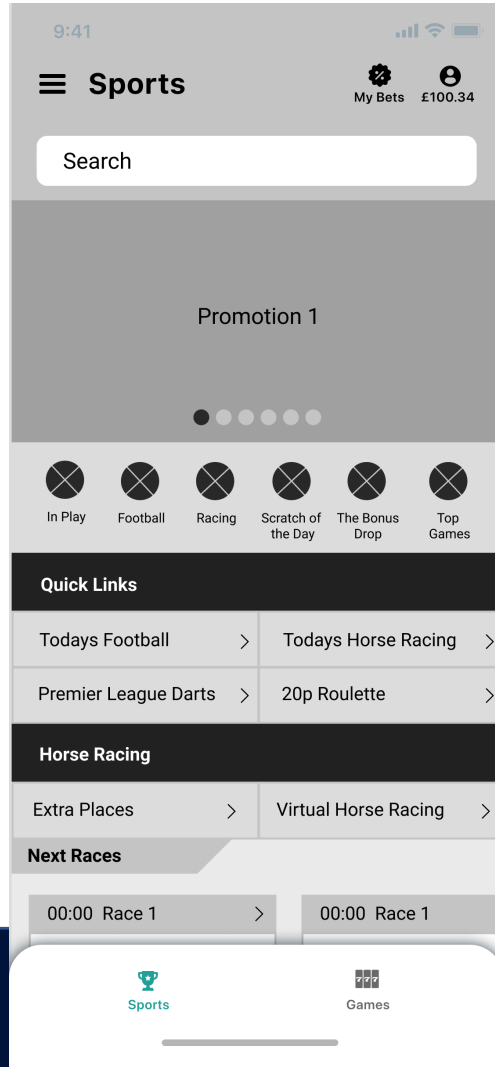
## Observations

- Users didn't miss the bet slip from the tab bar

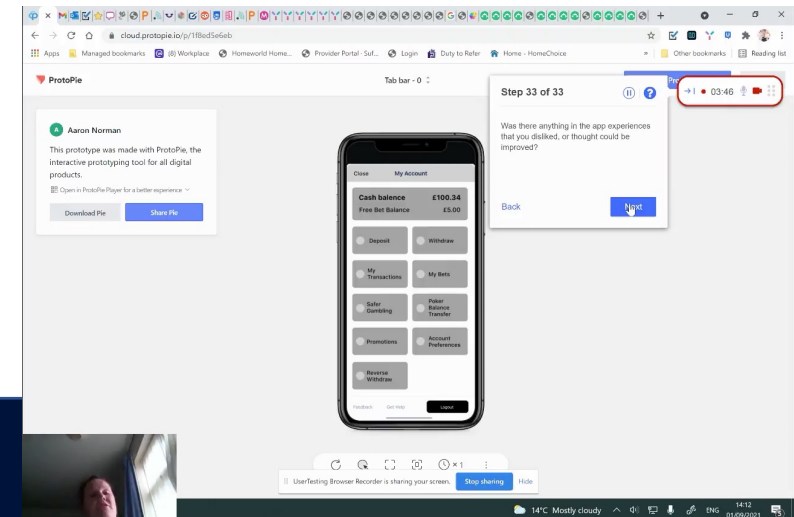
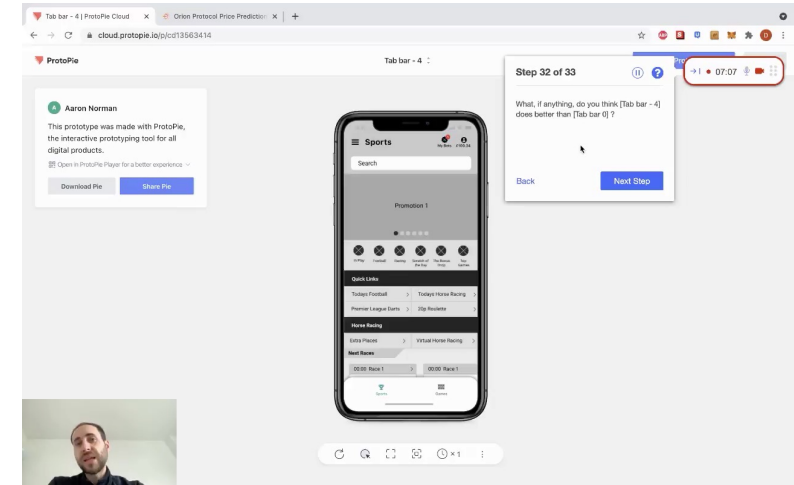
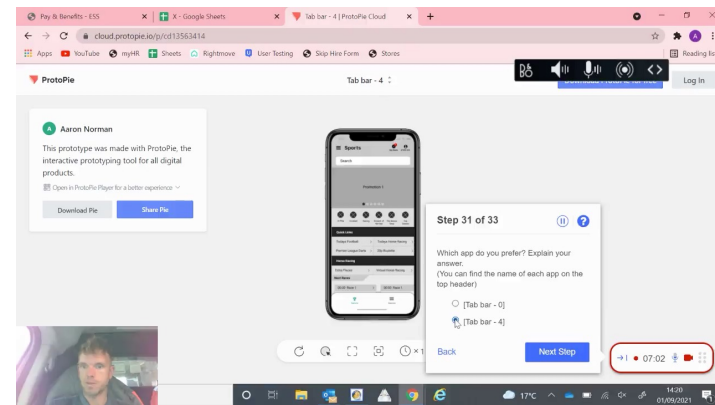

## Observations

When Betslip was removed from the tab bar 20/20 people did not notice it was gone and did not impact them placing a bet

The current Betslip solution is working fine

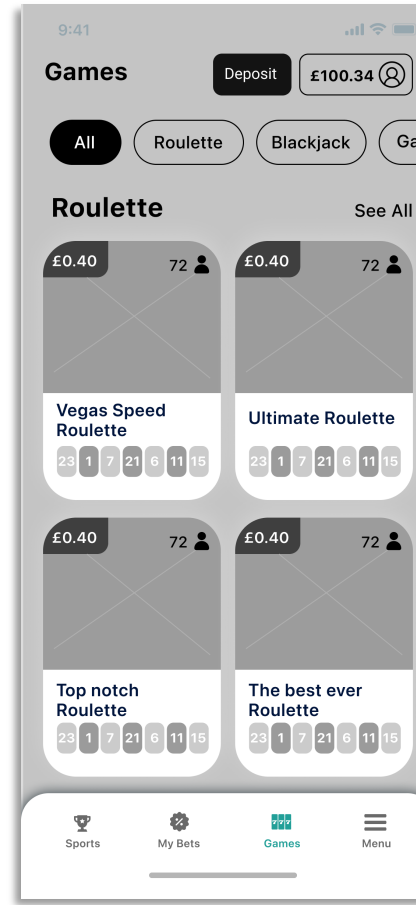
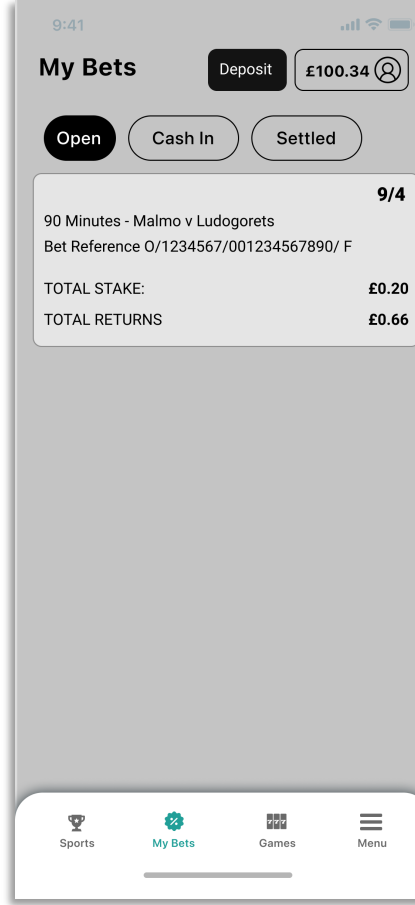
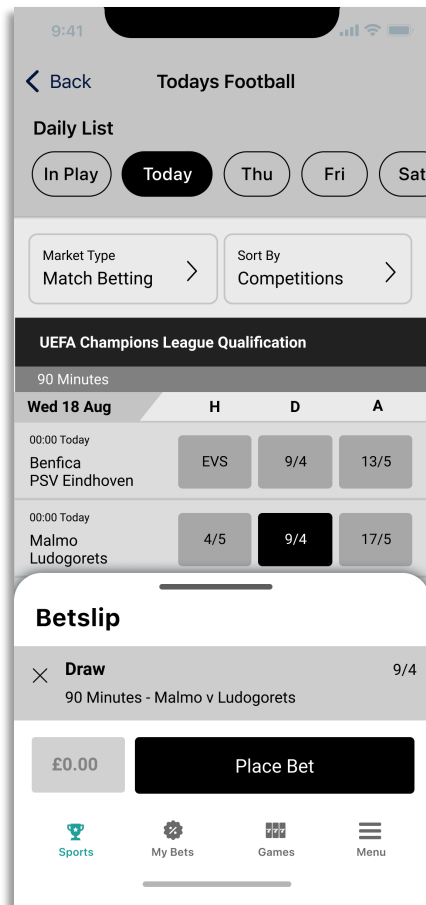
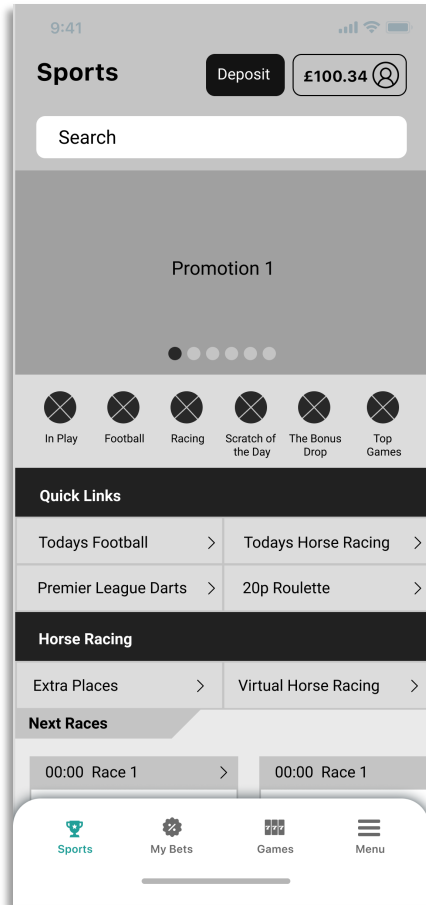
Sports Tab needs to be added

# Winning solution



## Observations

When Betslip was removed from the tab bar 25/25 people did not notice it was gone and did not impact them placing a bet – (including previous tests)

People loved the new minimise betslip function

Sports Tab needs to be added

Section Headers helped the users

Participants found Roulette just as easy in the games section if it is pushed to the top

Users found the new tab order a lot more clearer and useful
